

North Wales Shooting School Registration System

As of the 1st of January 2009 people who wish to shoot at NWSS will be required to register with us prior to using the facility and to log themselves in on each visit using the card that will then be issued.

The process will involve the completion of a registration form with your details and signing to accept the rules of the shooting school. The form will be used to enter the data into the registration system, and a registration card will then be issued.

You will need to bring the card with you each time that you come to practice but will not need to fill in the form every time and will no longer need to sign in the book.

In order that the registration be valid, you will need to present your shotgun certificate to a member of staff when you hand in your form so we can verify the details and give you an annual registration.

What will it cost ?

You can register for the day free of charge or you have the choice of an annual registration for a fee of £2.

Why are we doing this ?

As a result of recommendations made by the County Councils Health and Safety People regarding the control of the public on site.

Non-Certificate Holders

Non-Certificate holders will be required to register in the same way, we will expect that each non-certificate holder has had a lesson with NWSS within the last 12 months. Each non-certificate holder must be supervised by a registered certificate holder on a 1:1 basis. The form will also contain a declaration that you are not banned from the possession of a firearm under section 21 of the firearms act.

The registration does NOT remove the need to present your shotgun certificate for the purchase of cartridges.

We are doing this for the safety of everyone on the facility and to ensure that we can continue to run the facility in a sustainable way.
