Rules and conditions of registration - See the reverse of this sheet for air rifle rules

Registration at NWSS is based on the acceptance and understanding of the rules of operation of the shooting ground. Please read the information below and sign at the base of the page indicating that you have read and understood the rules of the ground and risks that you are accepting by requesting to use the facility. Your data will be held on file and on our database. The data will not be passed to other parties. A copy of the NWSS data protection policy is available on request.

Clay shooting carries an element of risk and your behavior on the shooting ground is an important part of the management of that risk in relation to yourself and others around you.

To protect yourself from injury, you must wear hearing protection and eye protection at all times on the shooting ground, whether shooting or as a spectator. In addition to this when shooting overhead targets you must also wear some protective headwear. This applies to all persons with you.

All non-certificate holders that wish to shoot must have undergone as a minimum a half hour lesson and safety brief by an NWSS instructor.

Non-certificate holders must be accompanied on a 1:1 basis by an experienced certificate holder who must supervise them at all times.

Gun safety is paramount and all shooters must familiarise themselves with the notices placed around the shooting ground regarding the safe handling and use of guns on the shooting ground.

Certain persons may under section 21 of the Firearms Act 1968 be prohibited from contact with firearms or ammunition. By signing below you are making the statement that "I the undersigned, declare that I am not a person prohibited from possessing firearms or ammunition under section 21 of the Firearms Act 1968"

NWSS reserve the right to revoke this registration and refuse entry to customers who do not adhere to the rules of the shooting school. No refunds will be given.

Air Rifle Information

Safety on the air rifle range is paramount, users of the range must read the following and sign at the base of the page indicating their understanding and acceptance of the rules and conditions of use.

The range is designed for air rifles only (NO PISTOLS) of 12 ft/lbs power or less (the legal limit for non-licensed weapons).

Use of high powered weapons is a danger to other users and damages targets on the range.

NWSS reserves the right to run spot checks on weapons used on the range.

If you are found to be using a weapon above the limit you will be asked to leave and may be reported to the Police.

Refusal to allow a spot check on your weapon will result in you being asked to leave.

Juniors (under 18) using the range MUST be supervised by an adult over the age of 21 AT ALL TIMES. The adult is responsible for ensuring they are familiar with the rules and the basics of safe shooting. Help is always on hand from staff and other shooters. If in doubt ASK.

Users of the range MUST NEVER walk out in front of the shooting position, as they risk being shot by another user.

Guns MUST ALWAYS be unloaded before they are removed from the shooting position. If a gun is being shared, it must remain unloaded on the table at the firing point while the shooter swaps position with the next shooter. The gun must remain in position on the desk, not swapped between shooters.

Air rifle shooting as with other shooting carries risks, pellets are able to ricochet from surfaces and we would recommend that shooters and spectators wear safety glasses whilst in the area.

Smoking is BY LAW not allowed in the air rifle range.

If you see someone behaving in an unsafe manner, approach them and point it out or call a member of NWSS staff on 01244 812219.

These rules are posted on the wall of the air rifle range for your reference.
